Thunderbolts and UniKL still top of the heap

SEKOLAH SUKAN TUNKU MAHKOTA ISMAIL (SSTMI) Thunderbolts and Universiti Kuala Lumpur (UniKL) continued their dominance in the MHC-MILÖ-NSC Malaysia Junior Hockey League for the fourth year. The 2013 edition which concluded last night saw Thunderbolts retain their league and overall title in fine fashion and were by far the best side from the start of the season. Majlis Bandaraya Petaling Jaya (MBPJ) certainly pulled a big surprise by finishing second in Division One, but their fairytale run came to a staggering end in the quarterfinals of the Milo Cup to lower ranked SSTMI Juniors. However, at the other end, it was probably one of the worst years for Bukit Jalil Sports School (BJSS). One of the most successful teams in the MJHL with seven league titles and five overall titles under their sleeves, they finished second from bottom in Division One. The team only registered one win and a draw from seven matches.
